All snow at the intersections must be plowed to the curb and as a result crosswalk curb ramps can get blocked with the wet, heavy snow from the plow. Our drivers do try and pile the snow away from crosswalk curb ramps when feasible but when cars are driving right behind our plows or vehicles are parked along the roadway you can't safely stop and backup to redirect the piles of snow. Violation is a minor misdemeanor.	Closed
6	4/19/2014	Agler/Stygler Road intersection; people not using turn lanes properly; traffic flow; dangerous & congested.	City has completed traffic study and is considering options; police will ticket violators.	Closed
7	4/19/2014	Need better zoning compliance and enforcement in Ward 1; variances; deed restrictions.	Deed restrictions not enforced by City; become civil court issue. Variances are approved on a case by case basis through the Planning Commission and/or Council.	Closed

8	4/29/2014	What is plan for pedestrian crossing in long stretches of Hamilton and Clark State and at roundabout; is it ADA compliant? Additional signage necessary for how to travel through roundabouts.	1) The roundabout at Hamilton and Clark State does have crosswalks with refuge areas to break the crossing into smaller distances for the pedestrian. These crosswalks are ADA compliant and must be in order for Gahanna to meet all State and Federal requirements. 2) Walkability is considered when roundabouts are designed and evaluation of the need for beacons will be ongoing. It is likely that an underground tunnel or overhead walkway at the Hamilton/Clark State intersection is cost prohibitive at this time. 3) We do recognize the need for instructions on how to navigate roundabouts and will do a public information push in addition to effective signage at the roundabouts. 15	5/13/2014	Concern about stormwater retention basin & swale behind property on Cherrybottom.	<p>The infrastructure that can become blocked is a Cherry Bottom Road culvert. The storm water division did receive a call on 11/15/13 where a resident said that he cleared a log from this culvert. Our crew told him to call us in the future when he sees that something has come downstream and is blocking that culvert. The resident also asked if we could install a grate on that culvert to make clearing blockages easier. Our crew considered this option and determined that a grate might actually increase the number of times that this culvert gets blocked and, therefore, did not think it would be a good idea. Our crew met with the resident at the Oklahoma service facility on 11/20/13 and explained their thinking regarding the grate.</p>	Closed
