



Design a Safe Driving Decal Contest Rules

Design Requirements

- Want to help improve safe driving around the City of Gahanna? We are looking for a creative, fresh decal design to be placed on City service vehicles. The decal will be used to remind those around the City to focus on driving and not be distracted by any of activities that could keep us from maintaining safe driving habits such as texting or using mobile devices.
- Designs be hand-drawn or graphically created images.
- Submissions should be your own work—no copyrighted materials will be accepted.
- Designs must fit within a 3 1/2 x 5 inch space (portrait or landscape). If submitting hand-drawn designs, use the space provided on the attached formed,
- The message or design should be simple, easy to understand, preferably limited to no more than two colors.
- Design should be visible from at least five feet away.
- The winner will be determined by a panel of judges: Greg Knoblock, Fleet Superintendent (City of Gahanna); Heidi Deane, Outreach Coordinator (Impact Teen Driving); Ashley Lawson, Visual Art Department (Gahanna Lincoln High School).
- The grand prize winner will receive \$200 and have their decals displayed on City service vehicles. The City will also award two \$25 prizes to runners-up.
- **Deadline to submit designs is March 1, 2016**
