RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEDICATION OF THE NEW
GAHANNA MUNICIPAL BUILDING IN HONOR OF
BRIGADIER GENERAL JAMES M. ABRAHAM

WHEREAS, The Gahanna Municipal Building expansion and modernization is finally well under way; and

WHEREAS, this fine facility will provide for Gahanna's growth well into the 21st century; and

WHEREAS, James M. Abraham has served the City for over 25 years as an exemplary citizen, as President of Gahanna Civic Center Inc. during the construction of the Gahanna Municipal Complex in 1969, as a Planning Commission member, and Chairman of the Commission in 1972; was elected to the Gahanna Jefferson School Board in 1972, and served as Director of Public Service in 1973 and 74;

WHEREAS, James M. Abraham served as Assistant Adjutant General under Governor Rhodes from January 1975 to November 1982, upon retirement, and was inducted into the National Guard Association Hall of Fame in April of 1991, and has served his country well; and

WHEREAS, we now turn our thoughts to the dedication of this long hoped for building;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council and Administration, on behalf of the citizens of Gahanna, propose to dedicate this Municipal Building in honor of James M. Abraham, our humble public servant.

Section 2. That this facility shall be dedicated and prosper with the spirit set forth by James M. Abraham to serve others above self.

Section 3. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
