



## Income Tax Reform Proposal on November 5 Ballot

Gahanna residents will be asked to vote on reforming the City's tax code on November 5, 2013. The reform proposal is to change the income tax rate in Gahanna from 1.5 percent to 2.5 percent. Concurrently, City Council will be voting to change the credit given for taxes paid to other cities from 83.3 percent to 100 percent.

If approved, this tax reform would generate approximately \$8 million in revenue annually. This money would allow for the City to sustain current service levels, increase street maintenance and invest in the community by implementing the five year capital improvement plan.
