



Income Tax Reform Information

Gahanna residents will be asked to vote on reforming the City's income tax code on November 5, 2013. The reform proposal is to change the income tax rate in Gahanna from 1.5 percent to 2.5 percent.

Concurrently, City Council will be voting to change the credit given for taxes paid to other cities from 83.3 percent to 100 percent.

Over the next weeks and months we would like the opportunity to come out and meet with local community groups, homeowners associations, civic and church groups to further explain the plan and answer all your questions. Tax Reform Proposal | Resident Income Calculator

The City of Gahanna has developed an online tax calculator that allows you to understand how the income tax reform proposal will impact your take home pay. As a reminder, local income tax is paid primarily to the city in which you work. The current proposal under consideration is to change the income tax rate from 1.5% to 2.5% and increase the credit given for

Soft Scale Causing Ornamental Tree Die Back



Homeowners with crab-apple or pear trees may want to take a closer look at tree branches with the rise of soft scale insects causing die back on these and other ornamental trees throughout the city. Soft scales are immobile insects that live most of their lives attached to
