

# Woodside Green Park Offers Visible Street Tree Replacement Options



Street tree replacement options are made visible along the trail and near the shelter house at Woodside Green Park, 230 Camrose Ct. Gahanna residents now have the opportunity to make well-informed choices to replace Ash trees that have been removed.

Like many other cities, Gahanna has lost a large number of Ash trees in the past years due to Emerald Ash Borer. Many of these trees were considered street trees. While the City has led the way in removing these hazard trees, it has also fielded a number of questions for street tree replacement options. In addition to being street tree replacements, the trees offer additional shaded space near the shelter house—another request from park users.

Residents are encouraged to visit Woodside Green Park with their smart phones or tablets, capture the QR code on the trees that catch their attention and read about it. Visitors will learn about the tree's Latin name, audio pronunciation, common name, planting conditions and images. Aside from the basic horticultural information, other information includes bloom time, size, soil and sun preferences.

"We always seek to educate our residents, visitors and students to be good environmental stewards," said Rob Wendling, city forester for the Department of Parks & Recreation.

"This project allowed the city to further diversify its urban forest—an important step in controlling the spread of insects and diseases in our urban landscapes."

Students from Columbus Academy supported city forester, Rob Wendling and parks staff, by planting 16 varieties of trees in the multi-use park. These trees include Miyabe Maple, Amur Maple, Lucas European Hornbeam, Common Hackberry, Turkish Filbert, Hardy Rubber Tree, Princeton Sentry Ginkgo, Espresso Kentucky Coffee Tree, Goldenrain Tree, Moraine Sweetgum, Amur Maackia, Wildfire Black Gum, Canada Red Cherry, Redmond Linden, Purple Robe Locust and Japanese Silk Lilac Tree.

A brochure is available for residents without QR code technology. These brochures will be available at the Parks & Recreation office at Gahanna City Hall and at the Woodside Green kiosk.

Additional benefits to the park include decreased air pollution, increased carbon fixation and additional habitat for animals that will make their homes in this park.

In February, the Department of Parks & Recreation received third place recognition by the Ohio Parks & Recreation Association for Park Area Development under \$1,000,000 for this project.

A full-time employee (spouse or child) of a business located within the City of Gahanna **must** provide proof of employment on company letterhead (with Gahanna address) signed by the personnel director or president of the company. Presentation of a valid photo identification of the employee is also required.

Please note that even if you have a Gahanna mailing address and/or live within the Gahanna-Jefferson School District, you **MAY NOT** be a qualifying resident of the City of Gahanna.

Fees must be paid at the time of registration. Only receipt of payment reserves enrollment. **All programs have limited enrollment.**

## Cancellation, Refund and Credit Policies

**CLASS CANCELLATIONS:** We will contact you if a class has been canceled or filled to maximum capacity prior to processing your registration. If you do not hear from us, please attend the first class.

**FACILITY CANCELLATIONS:** Reservations canceled more than 30 days in advance of the registration date will receive a refund, less at \$10 administrative fee. Cancellations 14-29 days in advance will receive a 50% refund; cancellations less than 13 days receive no refund. Changes or rescheduled reservations are subject to a \$10 administrative fee. No refunds for inclement weather.

**PROGRAM REFUNDS and CREDITS:** Refunds are only issued in instances when a class/program has been canceled by the Department.

**Absolutely no refunds will be issued for customer requested cancellations, classes and programs.**
