PURPOSE

The Department of Parks & Recreation is requesting fixed price quotes to provide experienced staff, labor plus all necessary materials, supplies and equipment to provide turf services for the Gahanna Municipal Golf Course.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Base Quote Scope: The base quote scope is for a complete turf care program for the turf areas in community parks throughout Gahanna. The selected Contractor shall fertilize all turf areas at least two (2) times each year with at least two (2) pounds of total nitrogen; 20-30% slow release, homogenous, turf grass quality fertilizer that will provide optimum health and appearance. Broadleaf weed control will be applied in the spring and the fall.

Option Years: Note that on the proposal there is an option year line to be completed for a second and third year for the services outlined herein. Please adjust pricing if necessary for these option years. The City of Gahanna may elect to exercise this option at any time.

CHEMICAL APPLICATION SERVICES

- A. Contractor shall provide routine chemical application services for all areas listed above and shall follow all manufacturers' instructions as well as all applicable laws.
- B. Contractor shall dispose of all waste materials or refuse off site.
- C. Contractor shall forward service reports for each site visit to the Parks Superintendent for review.
- D. The contractor must remedy items reported by the City of Gahanna within 48 hours after notice has been given of such deficiencies in work. This notification may be written or verbally communicated. Items not remedied in a timely fashion may, at the City's option, be completed by the City and deducted from payments due.
- E. Payment shall be made monthly for services completed. Invoices submitted shall be receivable on terms of net 30 days.

BROADLEAF WEED CONTROL

Broadleaf weed control for use in turfed areas shall be applied according to manufacturer's instructions and preferably a liquid application. Contractors must submit product name and application rates to be used with their quotes.

DAMAGES TO TURF AREAS

- A. Contractor shall be responsible for any and all damage caused by Contractor's operations, negligence or failure to act under the terms of the contract.
- B. Contractor shall replace, at no cost to the City, all shrubs, turf, trees, or plants that are damaged or killed due to Contractor's operations, negligence, or failure to act or use chemicals. If plant damage is caused by conditions beyond Contractor's control, replacement cost shall be at the City's expense.
- C. Contractor shall immediately replace all sprinklers that are damaged due to Contractor's operation. Damaged sprinkler replacement or repair shall be at Contractor's expense. The Parks Superintendent will provide the Contractor with a map of all irrigation heads.
