Tax Reform Proposal

On February 4, 2013, Gahanna City Council voted to place an issue on the May 7 ballot. The proposal is to change the income tax rate in Gahanna from 1.5% to 2.5%. Concurrently, Gahanna City Council is considering legislation that would increase the credit given to residents for taxes paid to another City.
