

Gahanna Credit Increase

The Mayor and a majority of City Council members have proposed reforming the City's income tax structure in order to sustain City services and fund the [Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan](#). The reform proposal has two components. The first of these components is to change the tax rate from 1.5 to 2.5 percent; this change must be determined by the residents and will be on the May 7 ballot as Issue 4.

The second component is to increase the credit given to residents who work outside the city from 83.3 to 100 percent. The credit change will be voted upon by Council on May 6. On Monday, March 18, Council passed a resolution affirming their intent to pass the credit change. You can read more about the credit change [here](#).
