Rocky Fork Creek Watershed is famous for its geological features:

- Bedford formation, Berea sandstone, and Sunbury shale from 320-360 million years ago
- These were all deposited in an ocean that covered most of Ohio about 12,000 years ago due to glaciations
- The shallow ocean had a depth of 100 to 1000 feet, whereas today's average oceans have a depth of 11,500 feet
