

Installment Billing Frequently Asked Questions

What is installment billing?

Installment billing allows a household to pay for camp registrations in up to 4 installments, depending on date of registration. When choosing the installment billing option, the designated percentage of the total registration fees, is automatically debited from a credit card or checking account on pre-defined dates.

Below are the dates and percentages charged for each registration period:

- **February 27—March 26, 2016:** 25% due at time of registration; 25% on March 27, 2016; 25% on April 27, 2016; 25% on May 27, 2016
- **March 27—April 26, 2016:** 34% due at time of registration; 33% on April 27, 2016; 33% on May 27, 2016
- **April 27—May 28, 2016:** 50% due at time of registration; 50% on May 27, 2016

****Installment Billing is not an option for any registrations on or after
May 27, 2016 ****

Can anyone use installment billing?

Installment billing is available for all Gahanna Summer Camp Experience camp options.

When can I register using installment billing?

You may register for installment billing between February 27 and May 27

What type of payment will be accepted for installment billing?

Installment billing can be paid using credit card or direct withdrawal from a checking account only.

What are the payment dates?

February 28th, March 27th, April 27th, and May 27th – percentages charged and number of dates is dependent on the date of registration.
