Proclamation

MARTIN LUTHER KING Jr. DAY

JANUARY 15, 2024

WHEREAS: Martin Luther King Jr. Day was established on November 3, 1983, by President Ronald Reagan to celebrate and honor the life and achievements of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and his efforts in the advancement of civil rights through nonviolent activism; and

WHEREAS: A Baptist minister, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. dedicated his life to advancing equality, social justice, and opportunity for all, and challenged all Americans to participate in the never-ending work of building a more perfect union; and

WHEREAS: The most influential of Black civil rights leaders during the 1960s, Dr. King was instrumental in the passage of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, which outlawed discrimination in public accommodations, facilities, and employment, as well as the Voting Rights Act of 1965; and

WHEREAS: Dr. King's teachings have continued to resonate for more than 50 years, as they guide and inspire us in addressing challenges of equality and opportunity for all within our communities; and


WHEREAS: Dr. King recognized that everyone can be great because everyone can serve, and during his lifetime encouraged all Americans to serve their neighbors and their communities; and
