

2024 Spring Day Trips

Activity Level Guide

Low: very little or no walking or standing

Medium: light walking, no more than 30 minutes for the entire trip, and some standing

High: heavy walking, over 30 minutes of the trip, and mostly standing

April 8 – Total Solar Eclipse Experience (12 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.)

Registration Opens Mar 4

Experience this once in a lifetime event! Travel to Delaware County where we can view the solar eclipse in totality. Staff will provide you with ISO Certified Solar Eclipse glasses so you can safely view this celestial event. We will stop for lunch before viewing the total solar eclipse which will start at 3:11 p.m.

Deadline: Mar 25 Fee: \$15; Lunch OYO

Activity Level: Low

April 26 – Titanic: The Artifact Exhibit at COSI (11 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.)

Registration Opens Mar 4

Experience the wonder and tragedy of the world's most famous ocean-liner, Titanic. More than 350 artifacts recovered from the wreck site of Titanic are on display in the exhibition along with full-scale room re-creations.

Note: this trip is rated as medium for low walking. However, there are few places to sit in the exhibit and long periods of standing are required.

Deadline: Apr 15 Fee: \$50; Lunch OYO

Activity Level: Medium

May 16 – Columbus Clippers vs Louisville Bats (11 a.m. – 4 p.m.)

Registration Opens Apr 1

Cheer on the Columbus Clippers as they take on the Louisville Bats, the Triple-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds.

Note: Seats are in Section 3 in right field. Seats are toward the top of the section but will require a few steps in order to reach seats.

Deadline: May 2 Fee: \$40; Lunch OYO

Activity Level: Low

May 31 – Hocking Hills (10:15 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.)

Registration Opens Apr 1

Visit one of Ohio's most breath taking natural areas. Stop for lunch at the charming restaurant Kindred Spirits at the Inn at Cedar Falls. Then explore the natural beauty of Ash Cave, one of the most impressive recess caves in the state.

Note: There is a $\frac{1}{2}$ mile trail that we will explore at Ash Cave. The trail is completely paved, but those who wish to get close to the cave may have to walk uphill on an unpaved trail.

June 13 – The Lion King at the Ohio Theater (10:30 a.m. – 5 p.m.)

Registration Opens May 6

The Lion King is an award winning stage musical tells the story of the young lion Simba who is destined to be king. Immerse yourself in this incredible story featuring songs written by Elton John being performed by talented actors.

Note: Seats are in the Orchestra Section and not require any steps to reach seats. However, a short walk down an inclined walkway is necessary to reach seats.

June 26 – Cincinnati Reds vs Pittsburg Pirates (10:00 a.m. – 6:30 p.m.)

Registration Opens May 6

Travel to the Great American Ball Park to catch America's National Pastime. Cheer on the Cincinnati Reds as they take on the Pittsburgh Pirates at this afternoon baseball game. **Transportation for this trip will be on a chartered bus.**

Note: Seats are in section 134 along the 3rd baseline. Seats are in near the top of the section and will require using 3-4 steps to reach seats.
