

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Gahanna, Ohio ("Owner") until **11 am**, local time, on **May 4, 2018** at the office of the Director of Parks and Recreation, 200 South Hamilton Road, Gahanna, Ohio 43230 for all labor, material, and services necessary for **Ward 1 Park ST-1060** (the "Project"), as more fully described in the Contract Documents prepared by OHM ("Design Professional"). Bids received after this time will not be accepted. Bids will be opened publicly and read immediately thereafter. Subject to the right of the Owner to reject any or all bids, the Owner will award contracts to the bidder(s) submitting the lowest and best bid(s). **Engineer's Estimate: \$696,144.45**

The Project will consist of developing a 7-acre parcel of land into a neighborhood park. Improvements include adding a parking lot, earthwork, landscaping, utility improvements as well as a portion of a multi-use path. It is anticipated that the work will commence on **June 7, 2018** and be completed by **October 19, 2018**.

No Bidder may withdraw its bid within sixty (60) days after the bid opening. The Owner reserves the right to waive irregularities in bids, to reject any or all bids, and to conduct such investigation as necessary to determine the lowest and best bidder for each contract.
